TOWN OF ANNETTA NORTH TOWN COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING MINUTES OCTOBER 13, 2020

The Town Council held its Regular Meeting at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday the 13th of October 2020 at the Annetta Methodist Church, Annetta, Texas

Mayor Robert Schmidt, Mayor Pro-Tem Rob Watson, Councilmembers Ken Hall, Stonie Hamilton were present and constituted a quorum. Absent were Councilmembers Len Callaway and Dr. John Johnson. Also, in attendance was City Attorney Bryn Meredith.

Call to order

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. A quorum was announced present Ms. Sheila Elmore took notes

Citizens' remarks on items of interest

There were no citizens' remarks on items of interest

Old Business

1. Discussion and possible action regarding the Jenkins Road LLC gate construction. City Council review of gate construction plans.

The Mayor and City Council reviewed plans to install a gate at the southernmost border of Jenkins Road. Jan Orr Harder from the Jenkins Road POA and City Engineer Shannon Nave provided additional input.

Councilmember Hall made a motion to approve the gate construction plans to extend the dead-end street distance requirement to twenty-eight (28) hundred feet. Councilmember Hamilton seconded the motion. Voting for were Hall and Hamilton. Abstaining was Watson. The motion carried 2-1

2. Discussion and possible action regarding the roads and bridges in the Town of Annetta North. City Council authorization of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) for dangerous tree removal on Buck Dobbs Road.

Mayor Schmidt updated the City Council regarding action taken to remove two dangerous trees at risk for falling on Buck Dobbs Road.

Councilmember Hall made a motion to approve the expenditure of fifteen hundred (\$1,500.00) dollars to remove the two dangerous trees and haul away the debris. Councilmember Hamilton seconded the motion. All present voted "aye." The motion carried 3-0

3. Discussion and possible action regarding the proposed new Willow Park Sewage Treatment Plant

Mayor Schmidt updated the City Council regarding the status of the proposed new Willow Park Sewage Treatment Plant. There was no action taken on this item.

4. Discussion regarding the 2021 fiscal year budget

Mayor Schmidt and the City Council reviewed a draft budget and made the following changes:

- 1. Projected Sales Tax Income-from \$20,000.00 to 30,000.00
- 2. Projected Income from Plats and Miscellaneous-from \$1,000.00 to \$7,500.00
- 3. Projected Attorney Fees-from \$15,000.00 to \$20,000.00
- 4. Projected Road Expenditures-from \$20,000.00 to \$35,000.00
- 5. Projected Engineer Fees-from \$2,500.00 to \$5,000.00

The 2021 fiscal year budget will be adopted at the November City Council meeting.
