

ORDINANCE NO. 96-7

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANNETTA NORTH, TEXAS :

I.

This is to certify that all candidates are unopposed for the 1996 election. In accordance with Sec.2.052 of the Election Code, Subchapter C, the election may be canceled if no candidate is opposed and no proposition is to appear on the ballot and there has been no declaration of write-in candidacy for any office on the ballot. The city council, by ordinance, may declare each unopposed candidate elected to office on receipt of this certification. A copy of the ordinance must be posted on election day, May 4, 1996, at each polling place that would have been used in the election.

II.

Should any section, clause or provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

III

This ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
