

RESOLUTION NO-2025-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANNETTA NORTH CALLING THE MAY 3, 2025 GENERAL ELECTION TO ELECT OFFICERS; DESIGNATING POLLING PLACES; APPOINTING ELECTION JUDGES; PROVIDING A JOINT ELECTION WITH PARKER COUNTY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Town of Annetta North, Texas (the "Town") is a Type A general law municipality located in Parker County, Texas, created in accordance with the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the terms of office of Town Mayor, Council Places 3, & 5 will expire in May 2025; and

WHEREAS, the first Saturday in May is the uniform election date set for the regular election to elect Mayor and Town Council members; and

WHEREAS, the election will be held as a joint election with Parker County, conducted under the authority of Chapter 271 of the Texas Election Code; and

WHEREAS, by this Resolution it is the intent to call the general election to elect municipal officers, to designate polling places, appoint necessary election officers, establish and set forth procedures for the election, and to authorize the Mayor to execute a contract with Parker County for conduction the elections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANNETTA NORTH:M

SECTION 1.

Town General Election Called. A general election shall be held at Parker County voting locations below on May 3, 2025, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., at which time the following officers will be elected:

Mayor

Councilmember Place 3

Councilmember Place 5

to serve from May 2025 to May 2027 or until their successors are duly elected and qualified.

SECTION 2.

Election Agreement with Parker County. The Contract for Election Services with Parker County (the “Election Agreement”) which includes the provision of voting equipment, supplies and services for the election, attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein for all purposes, is hereby approved, including the payment for such election services, and the mayor is authorized to execute the Election Agreement, the Election Agreement shall control.

SECTION 3.

Application for Place on Ballot. Qualified persons may file as candidates for the general election municipal officers by filing applications with the Town Secretary at secretary@annettanorth.com or calling 817-222-8405 from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on all regular business days from January 15th, 2025 through February 14th, 2025.

SECTION 4.

Polling Place. Voting shall be conducted on Election Day, May 3, 2025, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. at same polling locations as early voting in accordance with and pursuant to the Election Code.

SECTION 5.

Early Voting. Pursuant to the Election Agreement, Crickett Miller, Parker County Election Administrator is appointed as Early Voting Clerk

a. Early voting by personal appearance and election day voting (See attached)

Early voting times shall be as designated in the Election Agreement, including at least two (2) days during the early voting period where early voting shall be open for at least twelve (12) hours.

- b. Early voting by mail.** Crickett Miller, the Parker County Election administrator (“Elections Administrator”) is hereby designated as Early Voting Clerk for the general election. Applications for early voting by mail may be obtained by calling 817-598-6185. Applications may be delivered or mailed to the Elections Administrator at the following address: Early Voting Clerk 1112 Santa Fe Drive, Weatherford, Texas 76086. Applications for ballot by mail must be received by the early voting clerk no later than close of business on April 22, 2025.

- c. **Early voting Ballot Board.** Early voting, both by personal appearance and by mail, shall be canvassed by the Early Voting Ballot Board established by Parker County under the terms of the Election Agreement.

SECTION 6.

Election Judge and Alternate Judge. The Election Judge, Alternate Election Judge and Election Clerks shall be appointed by the Parker County Elections Administrator in accordance with the Election Agreement and the Election Code. Each official shall be compensated in accordance with the Election Agreement and Election Code.

SECTION 7.

Governing Law and Qualified Voters. The election shall be held in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Texas and the Election Code, and all resident qualified voters of the Town shall be eligible to vote at the election. All election instructions and ballots shall be printed in both English and Spanish language.

SECTION 8.

Publication and Posting of Notice of Election. This Resolution shall serve as the order for the general election as required by the Election Code. Notice of the election shall be given as required by the Election Code.

SECTION 9.

Delivery of Returns. The election officers shall make and deliver the returns of the election as specified in the Election Agreement and the Election Code. All election records and supplies shall be preserved by accordance with the Election Code.

SECTION 10.

Method of Voting. The voting systems and equipment are being provided by Parker County under the terms of the Election Agreement. All expenditures necessary for the conduct of the election, the purchase of materials therefore, and the employment of election officials are hereby authorized in accordance with the Election Code.

SECTION 11.

Necessary Actions. The Mayor and Town Secretary of the Town, in consultation with the City Attorney, are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary to comply with provisions of the Election Code in carrying out and conducting the general election, whether or not expressly authorized herein.


SECTION 12.
